SUMMER REVIVAL & RESOURCE EVENT

What an incredible four days we had on June 3-6. We kicked off Monday by setting up and sending out teams to invite individuals living in the woods, under bridges, and in abandoned places. God abundantly blessed our efforts—*473 guests* attended the revival where we served *347 breakfasts* and *543 lunches*. We provided *28 medical screenings*, *223 hygiene kits*, *123 pairs of reading glasses*, *52 haircuts*, and *215 clothing items*. With the help of *153 volunteers*, revival services were held daily under the tent. Best of all, four souls were saved, one rededicated his life to Christ, and two men found refuge at the mission. One man said through tears, *“I need God to take it all.”* And He did. All glory to God! A heartfelt *thank you* to Brother Travis Sharpe and the entire Unsheltered International team for sponsoring and pouring so much into this amazing revival. Your heart for the Lord and for the least of these is truly inspiring. We are grateful for your partnership and the eternal impact made during these powerful days of ministry.
